1. INFORMATION GATHERING PRACTICES

You can visit www.sciencexplorers.com without telling us who you are or revealing any personal information about yourself or you can choose to provide information about yourself. Our site uses a request form and email to gather information. We collect contact information like your name, address, phone, and email address that you voluntarily give us.

We use cookies. A cookie is a small data file that a website can place on your computer for record-keeping, administration, or to customize your experience. Cookies allow us to enhance your experience on our website. You may block or remove cookies on your computer by following the instructions on your web browser.

When you visit our site, we obtain information like the name of the domain and host from which you access the Internet, the IP (internet protocol) address of the computer you use, the browser and software you use, your computer operating system, the type and name of your ISP (internet service provider), what pages of our site you visit, the order of those pages, and the amount of time you spend on each page.

2. DATA PRIVACY

2.1 What information do we gather?

We may collect and process the following information in electronic and/or physical form (the "Information") from you:

Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Site, including information provided at the time of registering to use our site, subscribing to a service, posting material or requesting further information or services. We may also ask you for information if you report a problem with the Site.

If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.

We may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them.

Details of any transactions you carry out through the Site or otherwise and of the fulfillment of your orders.

If you want to sign up to receive our newsletter, we only ask for your email address. By providing this to us you are added to our mailing lists and, in addition to our newsletter, you will receive emails about our promotions from time to time. Should you decide in future that you do not wish to receive our news and promotions, you will have the opportunity to unsubscribe from the mailing list by clicking on the Unsubscribe button included in the emails.

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration purposes and to help us improve the Site. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

We do not knowingly collect or maintain information provided by children under the age of 13. Children under the age of 13 should ask a parent or guardian to provide their personal information online. 'Personal information' is information which identifies you or another person or is capable of doing so.

2.2 Password and Confidentiality

If you are provided with a user identification code, password or any other piece of information as part of our security procedures for a registration-only section of the Site, you are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your password and user name for the Site, and you are responsible for all activities that are carried out under them. We do not have the means to check the identities of people using the Site and we will not be liable where your password or username is used by someone else.

You agree to Contact Us immediately of any unauthorized use of your password or username of which you become aware. We have the right to disable any user identification code or password, whether chosen by you or allocated by us, at any time, if in our opinion, you have failed to comply with any of the provisions of these terms of use of the Site.

You may also be subject to investigation for misuse although your statutory rights remain protected.

2.3 How we use the Information

We use the Information held about you in the following ways:

- To register your application

- To ensure that the Site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer
- To provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, based on information we collect from cookies or where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes
- To send you relevant news if you have signed up to receive it

- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us
- To allow you to participate in any interactive features of the Site, when you choose to do so
- To check whether you are eligible for a competition and to contact you if you win

2.4 Will we share your information with anyone else?
